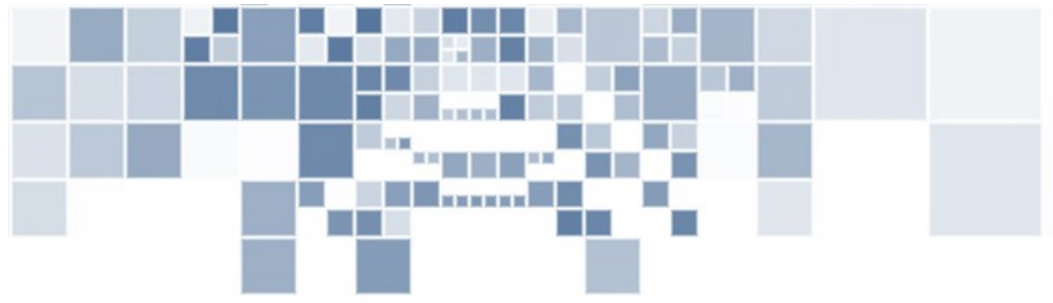

Sign in and Sign out from an e-Bank account.

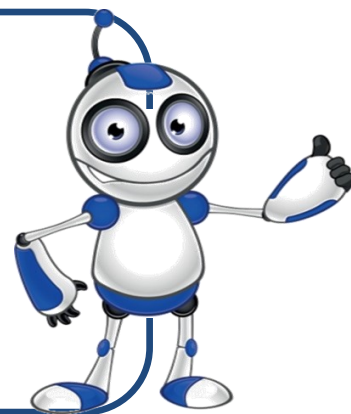


**Aims (What are you going to learn?):**

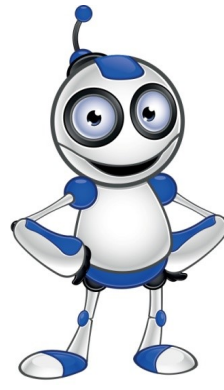

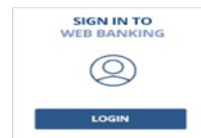

- ⇒ Do not allow your web browser application to save your passwords.



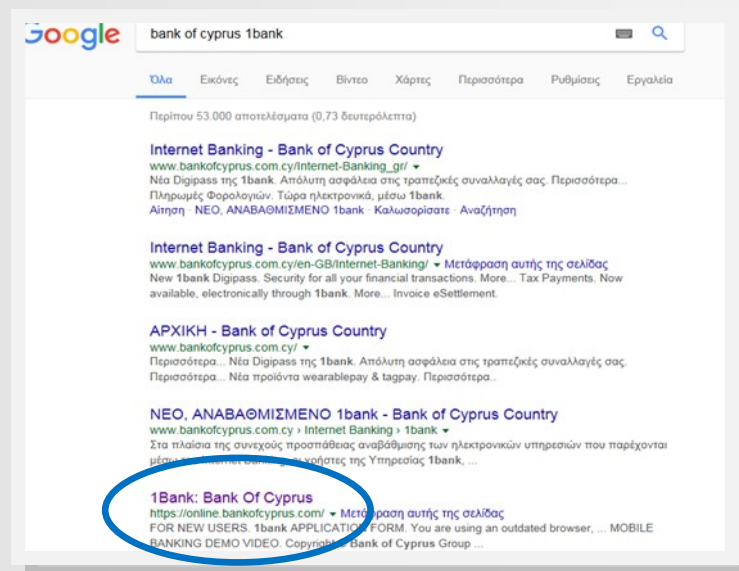
# STEPS

⇒ Open your web browser application and type your e-Bank web address:

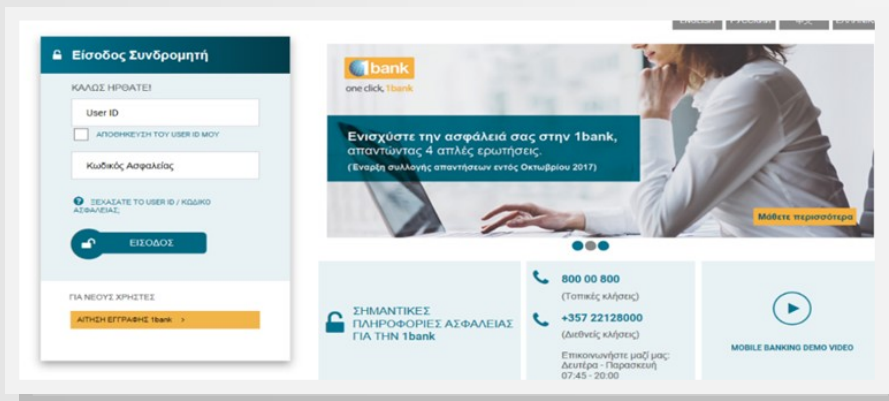

⇒ Alternatively, you can search the webpage through a search machine, such as Google:



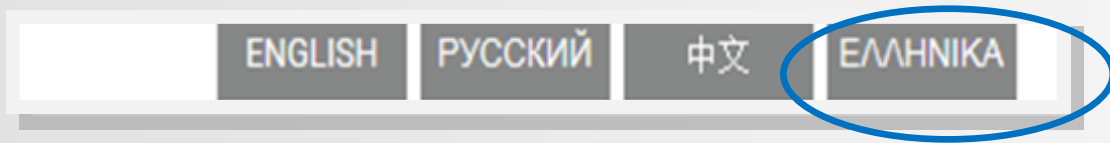

When you click on **ENTER** your details will be checked automatically and then you will have access to your e-bank.

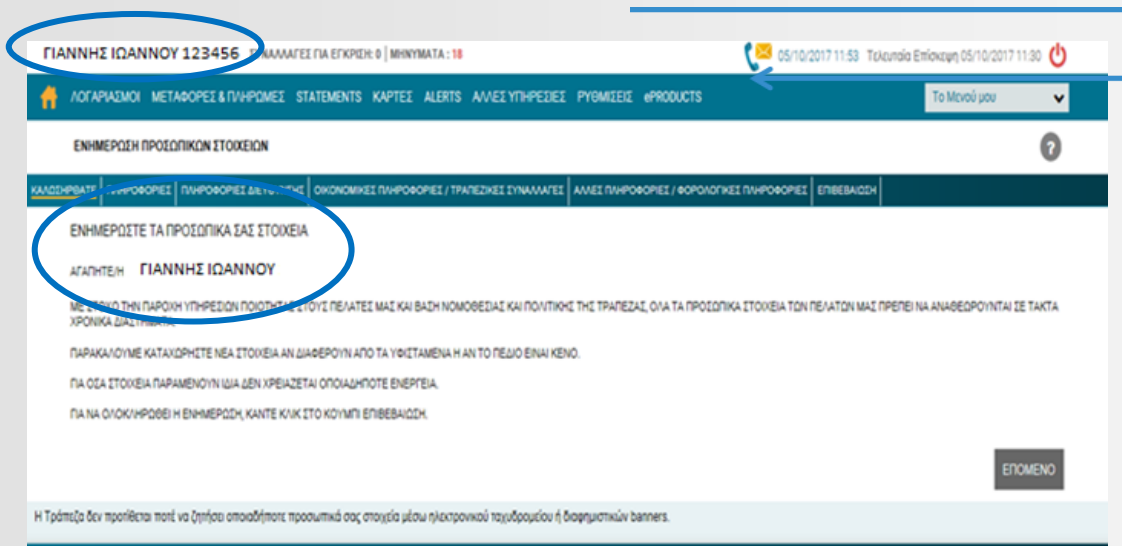

After successfully entering your e-Bank the a screen will appear, as presented in the image below, containing:

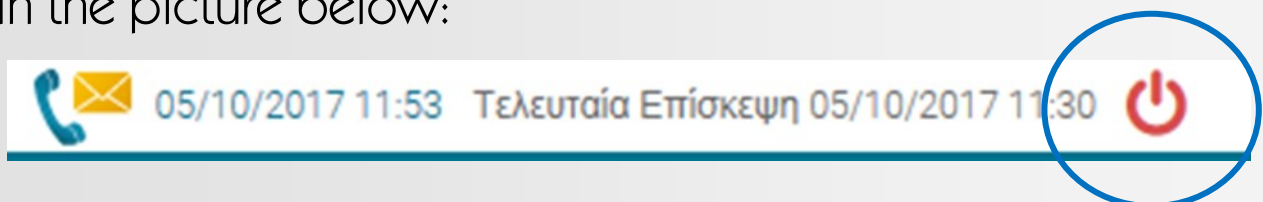
⇒ Your personal details and all your options menus.
